
Under the patronage of The

By creating this permanent, public memorial to recognize all members of the Canadian Armed Forces and the Public Service of Canada who served their country during the Mission, GVAMPS will honour and draw public attention to their service and the Mission. The Memorial will specifically list by name all members of the Canadian Armed Forces and the Public Service of Canada who made the supreme sacrifice during the Mission. In addition, the Memorial will recognize the support of families and those who returned with mental and physical wounds.

Located in a public green space, immediately adjacent to Christ Church Cathedral and Pioneer Square, in the downtown area of the City of Victoria, the Memorial will be wheelchair accessible and will be located on a pedestrian walkway, visible from Quadra Street, a main thoroughfare.
